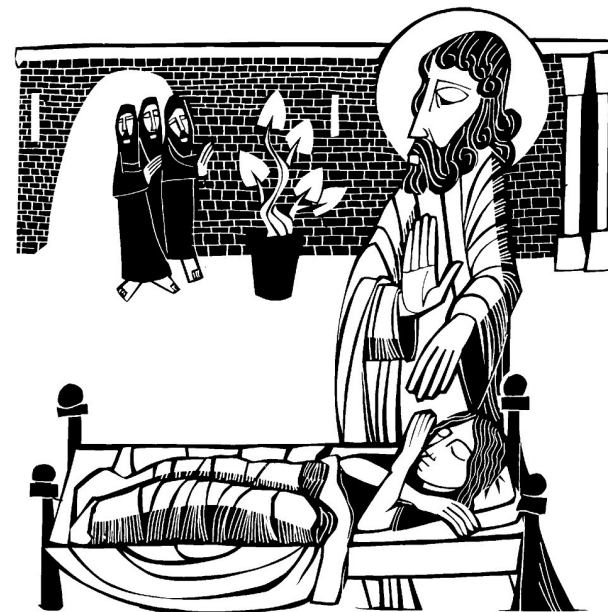

Gift Aid : A big thank you to all those who Gift Aid their collection. As a result the parish will receive £9,579.10 from the Inland Revenue for the tax year 2017/18

Remember you must have paid at least the same amount of tax to cover the reclaimed Gift Aid amount, i.e. if you give £10 per week that equals £520 per year and the parish claim £130, so you must have paid at least £130 tax in the year.
